It has sure been hot lately, now that it's Fall....Summer shows up, I say BRING IT ON! Because we have the coldest beer in town, thanks to Jeff Claytor for all his hard work with the coolers, refrigerators, freezers swamp coolers and air conditioners in our Post.

FINANCES

To all the Members / Owners of the Post 716 Family, we all need to buckle down and support the Post now more than ever. Now that our Finance Officer has finally been brought up to speed, he has warned me and the rest of the Executive Committee that we can no longer continue to do business like we have been in the last year or so or we would be going under water in 6-8 months.

So as of 30 September the E-Board has recommended freezing all donations and to eliminate all unnecessary purchases. Also that the monthly mail-

ing of the newsletter be cut down to (4) per year (saving almost \$4000 per year) and that the E-mail remain at (12) or more per year.

I will be asking that we limit the use of the air conditioners in the hall to special functions only and that we all conserve as much electricity, gas, water, and paper products (cups, napkins trash bags etc). as possible in the rest of the Post, **HOWEVER PLEASE USE AS MUCH TOILET PAPER AS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE JOB!**

We also need to start aggressively marketing the hall for rent. Tell your friends and neighbors that we have a nice hall for rent that holds up-to 232 for dinner and 500 for assembly.

We are now asking for your year end tax deductible donations designated to a special program, in Honor of a certain Member or Family or to the building fund.

I am very confident that in a few months, with our Legion Family's support, we will be moving in the right direction and be able to feel safe about donat-

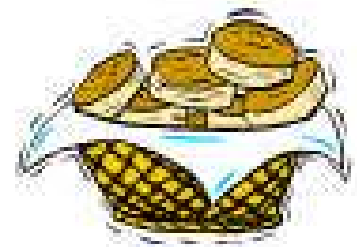

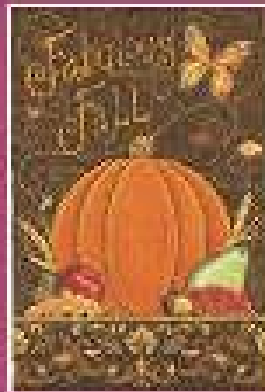
