In the bar, remember, the Bar Counter is not to be used to discuss Post business. If you wish to discuss Post business, please be courteous to others and relocate to a table or to the hall area. The Bar Counter should be used for general conversations and drinking!

When helping out with activities and the community service personnel are helping, remember that there are only two people actually telling them what to do. The first and overall authority is the bartender. They will send the community service personnel to the areas that need help, say the kitchen during a function. In this case, the person in charge of the event is the authoritative person. So, if you need the assistance of one of the community personnel, check with the person in charge and ask if you can utilize one of the community personnel for a minute (or two). Basically, lets not have everyone in the kitchen telling them what to do.

Last item, lets be friends! Everyone has their own reason for coming down to the Post. Everyone has their own problems, like me, that they try to forget while at the Post, so, lets all be one happy family and treat and trust each other while at the Post!
